LRSWMD Recycling Specifications – All in One Bin



Plastics

- ✓ Sour cream, cottage cheese & yogurt tubs
- ✓ Non-foam plastic egg cartons
- ✓ Frozen food trays
- ✓ Hinged food containers, such as fast food & deli containers
- ✓ Pastry & cookie trays
- ✓ Tupperware & other similar food storage containers
- ✓ Vegetable & fruit containers
- ✓ Flower pots & seedling trays
- ✓ Plastic pails with handles removed up to 5 gallons in size
- ✓ Six pack, soda or beer boxes
- ✓ Milk, cider, spring water & windshield washer jugs
- ✓ Bottles used for cleaning products
- ✓ Laundry bleach jugs
- ✓ Shampoo & dishwashing detergent bottles
- ✓ Soda & seltzer bottles
- ✓ Juice, water, cooking oil bottles & peanut butter jars



Paper, Glass & Metal

- ✓ Newspapers, including inserts
- ✓ Magazines, catalogs, phone books & glossy paper
- ✓ Corrugated cardboard (please flatten)
- ✓ Paper bags
- ✓ Boxboard (paper towel tubes, shoe boxes, CLEAN pizza boxes & other dry goods boxes)
- ✓ Office paper (including copier paper & gift wrap)
- ✓ Regular & window envelopes with mail removed
- ✓ Shredded paper (must be in clear, plastic bags)
- ✓ Glass bottles & jars (food & beverage only)
- ✓ Aluminum foil (including pie plates)
- ✓ Metal cans (food & beverage cans only)
- ✓ Aerosol cans (must be empty)



Recycle These Items Too!

- Tires
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Batteries
- Electronics
- Textiles
- Books
- Computers
- All scrap metal

DO NOT Recycle These Items

- ✗ Refrigerator or freezer boxes
- ✗ Detergent boxes
- ✗ Bags with plastic handles
- ✗ Tissues
- ✗ Oily pizza boxes
- ✗ Drinking glasses
- ✗ Toys
- ✗ Sleds
- ✗ Electronic housing
- ✗ No styrofoam, plastic peanuts or film (plastic bags, plastic wrap)
- ✗ Cookware, ceramics or dishes
- ✗ Motor oil bottles or cans
- ✗ Containers, caps, lids under 2" wide
- ✗ Milk or drink boxes
- ✗ Pet food bags
- ✗ Carbonless paper
- ✗ Food soiled paper
- ✗ Tyvek envelopes
- ✗ Medicine bottles
- ✗ Laundry baskets
- ✗ Housewares
